I hereby waive and release the CAROLINA DOG TRAINING CLUB, INC., hereinafter referred to as the "Training Club", its officers, members and agents from any and all liability of any nature, for injury or damage which I or my dog may suffer, including specifically, but without limitation, any injury or damage caused by the action of the dog. I expressly assume the chance of such damage or injury while attending any training class, or any other function, of the Training Club or while on the training facility or neighboring area thereto.

In consideration of and as inducement to the acceptance of my application for training membership by the Training Club, I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless this Training Club, its officers, members and agents from any and all claims, or claims by any member of any family or any other person accompanying me to any training class or function of the Training Club, or while on the facility or neighboring area thereto as a result of any action by any dog, including my own.

I understand that attendance of a dog obedience training class is not without risk to my dog, myself, members of my family or guests who may attend because some of the dogs to which I will be exposed may render difficulty in controlling and may result in injury even when handled with the greatest amount of precaution. In addition, it is my responsibility to keep my dog current on vaccinations, but I recognize that puppies may still be susceptible to various diseases in spite of the vaccinations.

I also understand the potential health risk in exposing a young puppy, without complete disease immunity, to other dogs. I release the Training Club from any liability relating to this.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CAROLINA DOG TRAINING CLUB CLASSES

CLASS FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AFTER THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS (ORIENTATION WEEK)

Classes are held at the Lewis Recreation Center on Forest Lawn Drive. This is located off Pisgah Church Road between Battleground Ave (Hwy 220N) and Lawndale Drive. If you have questions, please call the above phone number and leave a message or email classes@carolinadogtrainingclub.com

- 1. BEGINNER 1 CLASS: DO NOT BRING YOUR DOGS THE FIRST NIGHT OF CLASS. Both the 7:45 class and the 8:45 classes will meet at 7:45 on the first night for orientation and instruction.**
- 2. BEFORE CLASSES START:** (1) For the protection of all concerned, EVERY owner must provide proof of vaccinations from a veterinarian for Rabies, Distemper/Parvovirus (DHLP-P or DA2PPV), and Bordetella with the application. NO DOG WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT THIS DOCUMENTATION (Puppies under 6 months of age must have at least 2 Distemper/Parvovirus boosters, and at least 1 Bordetella booster vaccine before the start of class). (2) **All paperwork MUST be completed by the first night of class, including application form, waiver, vet records, and payment. NO EXCEPTIONS, you will not be allowed to bring your dog to class without these.**
- Litter mates or dogs from the same household should not be placed in the same Beginner 1 classes because they are easily distracted by each other. We highly recommend enrolling at different times.
- On class nights, enter only through gym entrances. Dogs are not allowed in any other part of the building, including the front office area, hallways, and restrooms.
- To prevent dog fights, keep your dog on a short leash when entering or leaving the building or talking to others. Do not allow your dog to sniff or play with other dogs during class.
- Come to class with your dog's normal collar. We recommend you use a 4 or 6-foot long, ½-inch wide cotton web leash. Narrow nylon or flexible leather leashes are also acceptable. We have leather leashes for sale at the start of class – see your instructor if you want to purchase a leash from us.
- Do not feed your dog after 4:00 p.m. on class nights. However, we do recommend that you bring a water bowl and small, soft food treats to class. (Hard biscuits are not suitable as training treats.)
- Please walk your dog before coming to class. Owners are responsible for cleaning up their dog's accidents and spilled drinking water. The club will provide clean-up supplies.
- Dress in casual, comfortable clothes (e.g., pants, sweats, shorts). Full skirts hamper the dog's vision and may become caught up the leash. Avoid noisy, dangling jewelry. Wear low-heeled, rubber-soled shoes. **NO LOOSE SANDALS, FLIP-FLOPS OR HIGH-HEELS.**
- Female dogs in season are not allowed in class. If your dog comes in season, please notify your instructor. You may attend classes without your dog. **Class fees are non-refundable after the first class.**
- After you miss 3 consecutive classes, you will be dropped from the class. **Class fees are non-refundable.**
- To keep up with the class, training at home is part of the commitment. We recommend a total of 15-20 minutes a day at home. Remember, though, that all your everyday activities with your dog should involve training and management, so getting in 15-20 minutes should be easy (it doesn't have to be all at one time).
- One person should train a dog during entire class session. Family members are welcome to observe in the stands. Children observing should remain in the stands so that your dog is not distracted by them.
- Visitors are welcome, but are requested to refrain from loud or excessive talking. Children must be closely supervised, quiet and kept away from all dogs in class.
- Owners are responsible for any and all damage incurred by their dogs to other dogs, people and/or property.
- The Training Director, at his/her discretion, reserves the right to dismiss any dog from class without a refund. If your dog is not under control (see Policy on Controlling Dogs) and/or presents a danger to others, you will be dismissed from class.**
- In case of snow or inclement weather, check the radio or TV (If the Guilford County Schools are closed, our classes are canceled), or check our facebook page for cancellations. Any canceled classes will be made up at the end of the session.
